



## How to Use Pinterest for Landscape Inspiration


### Step 1: Go to the Pinterest website

Visit [www.pinterest.com](http://www.pinterest.com)




### Step 2: Create your account

Sign up with your email or Facebook account. If you have an existing Pinterest account, simply sign in.



### Step 3: Create a board (or few!)


You can create as many boards as you want and label them as you wish, but to ensure we can locate the board dedicated to your landscape inspirations, please create a “McCabe’s Nursery Inspiration Board” and include your last name in the title.



### Step 4: Begin Pinning

Once your board is created, you are ready for Pinning! There are various ways you can add pins to your board:

1. Use the search field in the Pinterest browser to find pictures you love and pin as you go.
2. Upload photos you have saved on your computer.
3. Use the Pin It Button on your browser to Pin around the web. Once you have the Pin It button, you can save images from your favorite blogs, sites and catalogs to your boards.


